Program Fees

There will be a charge of \$1000 assessed to each student to cover the cost of the IB Registrations, Exams, Trainings, Office Charges, Student events, and other fees that are not covered by Baldwin County. The cost of the program will be broken into four payments at the beginning of each school year- 9th – 12th of \$250.00. These fees are *nonrefundable*. Parents/ Guardians may choose to pay monthly to meet the required \$250 by the end of the school year. The office will not bill monthly. This is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Scholarships are available on a “need” basis. Scholarship Applications are opened at the beginning of each school year. ***A student may withdraw from the program only at the end of each school term due to scheduling purposes.***

Athletic Eligibility/ Zone Requirements

- 9th Grade students who transfer within Baldwin County school district to an IB school from a school that ends at 8th grade are automatically eligible for athletics.
- 10th Grade Baldwin County students who transfer to an IB school from another high school must sit out a year.

STATEMENT OF AWARENESS

- I understand that the International Baccalaureate Program is a college- preparatory and continuing educational program requiring *strong academic and time management skills*.
- I also understand that the *9th and 10th grade classes are preparatory* and do not commit me to, nor automatically admit me to the 11th and 12th grade IB Program.
- I also understand that the IB and Pre-IB Faculty *will determine* if I am allowed to continue in the Pre-IB or IB Program the following school year, based upon my collective performance including but not limited to *academic standards, disciplinary action, attendance, and honor* at DHS.
- I understand that I must meet the minimum grade point average of 2.5.
- I understand any disciplinary actions may result in my removal from the DHS IB Preparatory program at the sole discretion of the DHS Administration and Coordinator.
