## PROSPECTIVE CHEERLEADERS AND PARENTS:

The 2022-2023 Bay Minette Middle School Cheerleading Squad will be one squad composed of 7<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> graders. In addition to the many responsibilities of cheerleaders, **all** cheerleaders will be required to represent BMMS at potential competitions, events, and/or fundraisers. Cheerleading is a sport that requires dedication, sacrifice, and teamwork. If you are able to commit to this type of responsibility, please turn in the attached documents and fee by February 18, 2022.

## **APPLICATION FEE**

- There is a \$20 application fee
- \$20 is due by February 18<sup>th</sup> (must be paid before clinic)
- Cash or checks accepted (checks made out to Bay Minette Middle School if check, please put phone number somewhere on the check)

- February 25: tryouts will start after school around 3:15 (BCHS GYM)
- March 8: uniform fittings

#### WHAT TO WEAR

- CLINICS: T-shirt/tank, shorts, & tennis shoes (any athletic wear is fine)
- TRYOUTS: Black shorts, PLAIN white t-shirt or tank, tennis shoes, white ribbon/bow. Hair needs to be put ALL the way up in a ponytail for clinics and tryouts.

## CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS AT TRYOUT

- TRYOUT DANCE
- TRYOUT CHEER
- TOE TOUCH
- JUMP OF CHOICE (HURDLER, PIKE, ETC.)
- RUN OUT (SPIRIT, TUMBLING\*, ETC.) \*TUMBLING IS NOT REQUIRED, BUT WILL BE INCLUDED IN POINT TOTALS

#### **TEACHER EVALUATIONS**

- 2 teacher evaluations-1 must be a current teacher/coach
- Failure to get 2 evaluations will result in points deducted at tryouts
- Current/former BMMS Cheerleaders will receive evaluations from the coaches (will count as one of your two evaluations)

## COST

- Cheer expenses vary from year to year but have ranged from \$1,000-\$1,200 in past years. (We will try to keep this as low as possible. We will fundraise as much as possible to go towards personal costs).
- If your child makes the BMMS squad, there will be a \$250 non-refundable deposit due March 7th to pay the camp deposit.

### CHEERLEADER EXPECTATIONS

Promoting good sportsmanship by demonstrating it is required at all times.
 Cheerleaders should not be using foul language or doing crude things at school, practice, games, camp, etc.

- All squad members are to participate in fundraisers, making posters/banners, and any school or community events that the squad is scheduled to participate in.
- Cheerleaders are not allowed UNEXCUSED absences. The coach should be notified at least two weeks PRIOR if someone is going to miss practice, etc. (exception would be sudden sickness in which the cheerleader is required to contact the coaches at earliest possible time.) Circumstances determine action taken. Once making the squad, a more detailed explanation of all these things will follow.
- To work as a team member and not an individual. Cheering requires everyone doing their part to be successful!
