This year DHS Senior student drivers will have the opportunity to rent and paint/personalize a parking space on campus. The parking spaces will be rented at a cost of **\$100** which includes your school parking permit. The parking spots are LIMITED and ONLY SENIORS will be given an opportunity to rent a parking space. You will only be able to receive a spot to paint once all required paperwork is turned into the office for your regular parking along with this form.

A map of parking spaces will be available and can be selected on a first come first serve basis beginning July 2020 - August 2020.

You will not be able to purchase the painted spots online.

Parking forms must be complete in order to select a parking space. There will be THREE days that the painting will be done. The paint days will be on Friday, July 31st (8 am until), Saturday, August 1st and Sunday, August 2nd. The rainout makeup weekend will be determined at a later date. The parking space design request form will be included in your packet. The design of your parking space will need to be submitted and approved by a DHS administrator/PTSO Board Member before any painting will be performed.

Guidelines for your Design (Sketch):

Think of our space as a t-shirt you would wear to school. Your parking spot must meet dress code approval!

- No Offensive Language, pictures or symbols
- No negative or rude language
- No "gang style tagging", drugs, alcohol or violence
- You may include your name, jersey number, instrument you play, your hobby, famous quotes or slogans and anything unique to you so as it meets with administrative approval.
- Only YOUR NAME. A boyfriend or girlfriend's name is NOT allowed.
- Prohibited or unapproved designs/items will be painted over at the discretion of the Principal or PTSO Board member. Disciplinary action may be taken and you may forget your right to a parking space and/or to drive on campus.

NO POLITICAL STATEMENTS OR SYMBOLS WILL BE ALLOWED

Paint Requirements:

WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint is the only type of paint that can used. Students will so have to leave a four-inch unpainted border between the white parking space lines and the paint in their parking spot. You will be required to use blue painters tape to ensure this border is accomplished.

You may purchase WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX paint at retail stores like Sherwin Williams, Lowes, Home Depot, and Ace Hardware. **All paint and tape will be the responsibility of the student.**

Students will be required to paint over the entire parking spot at the end of the school year by Monday, May 6th with black paint. Failure to paint the spot will result in the senior not participating in graduation activities until the spot has been painted. Failure of the student to cover any vandalism or to repaint the spot at the end of the year will result in a \$75.00 fine along with not participating in graduation activities. If a student intends to withdraw before the end of the school year, the student will have to paint over the spot before he/she will be cleared to withdraw.

Unapproved Paints:

- No Oil Based Paints
- No Reflective Paint
- No Spray Paint
- No Fluorescent Paint

What to bring to paint:

Be sure to bring your approved design/sketches with you on paint day. Also, you will be responsible for all paint brushes, rollers, paint pans, and paint tape. You will want to bring sunscreen, stencils, rags for cleaning, sacks or bags to dispose of trash, a drop cloth, and paint clothes. **DO NOT BRING ANY KIND OF PAINT SPRAYERS OR CLEAR COAT!!** This will be a great activity and fundraiser and hope to make this a tradition at DHS.

*Only in case of rain will date be changed.

**Painting will only be permitted on designated paint day.

Should there be an issue with your painted spot as far as vandalism or if another student parked in your spot, it is your responsibility to bring it to the attention of an administrator. You will then be instructed on how this will be handled.
