

Homecoming 2019

Congratulations on being selected to represent your class on the SFHS Homecoming Court! As this event is very involved, specific, and considered an honor, below you will find information in regard to requirements and expectations.

The following number of students will be selected to represent each class:

- Class of 2020- six girls
- Class of 2021- four girls
- Class of 2022- four girls
- Class of 2023- four girls

Any GIRL selected as a 2019 Homecoming Maid is required to participate in the following Homecoming Week Activities:

- Daily dress up days
- Practice with band on Wednesday, September 18th and Friday, September 20th during fourth block (**that's your last class of the day**)
- the Homecoming Pep Rally/Parade @ SFHS on Thursday, September 19th. (escorts too). **Please understand that parking is limited. Allow sufficient time to park. You will need to be on the hill at 5 pm. Please make sure to secure a car- usually a convertible (two maids per car, so find a buddy within your class to share a car).**
- the Homecoming Mother and Daughter Tea (September 19th promptly at 1:30 pm in the SFHS library. We begin regardless of whether you are present or not.)
- the morning Homecoming assembly on September 20th in the gym. You will **not** need an escort for this.
- the half-time presentation during the September 20th football game. You will need an escort. See below for further details.
- the call out portion of the 2019 Homecoming Dance on September 21st at the SFHS gym *(date too)
(You will need to be @ the dance no later than **7:45 pm**. Call-outs will begin at 8 pm. **If you are not present, your name will NOT be called out.**)

Additional Information concerning court:

- All maids who are selected to represent the court will be required to attend meetings (September 10th and September 17th at 7:30 am in Mrs. Quinn's room).
- Maids will be required to wear a **school appropriate** dress suit to the Mother/Daughter tea on September 19th at 1:30 pm in the library. The same suit can be worn to the pep rally (meet at 5:00 pm on the hill, unless given further instructions).
- All maids (9-12) need to secure a football player escort for the Homecoming Pep Rally.
- All maids should wear the following SCHOOL APPROPRIATE ATTIRE for the homecoming assembly on Friday, September 20th: White jeans, black tunic/dressy top (must have sleeves, no backless, no crop-tops, no one shoulder, no strapless, no see-through—If you wouldn't wear it to church, don't wear it to school. If you question the blouse, don't wear it. If you need ideas of where to purchase the top, please see Mason/Quinn.), and black sandals (please do not put yourself in misery with heels/pumps that you cannot walk in all day).
- For the halftime presentation, girls will wear a **black** dress. Black dresses must be KNEE LENGTH AND (no see-thru, off shoulder, or strapless) approved by either Ms. Mason or Mrs. Quinn PRIOR to game day. (WE MUST APPROVE YOUR DRESS, OR YOU WILL NOT PARTICIPATE!)
- All maids need to secure an escort for the halftime presentation. This should be father, mother, grandfather, uncle, etc... Halftime presentation escorts WILL NOT be a student. Dress for escorts for halftime presentations should be Sunday best (dress shirt, tie/bowtie, jacket recommended, but not required).

-Families of Homecoming Maids **MUST** purchase a ticket to attend the football game on September 20th—this includes escorts. Maids will get in free.

-Homecoming court members and their dates **MUST** purchase a ticket to attend the Homecoming Dance on Saturday, September 21st.
