WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

Dual enrollment allows students to take classes that count for both high school and college credit.

Dual enrollment students have access to everything the College has to offer:

- Advising and counseling
- Online tutoring services
- Student activities, organizations, and athletic events
- Campus amenities
- Student discounts at local and national businesses



BALDWIN COUNTY ACADEMIC DUAL ENROLLMENT

One tuition-free academic course per semester.

Any additional course is \$164 per credit hour!

3 credit hours - \$492

Payment plan available

Tuition costs are current but subject to change each school year

No location restrictions

Fully online and hybrid courses available

No credit hour limitations

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ACADEMIC COURSES

- 10th, 11th, or 12th grade
- GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Minimum Test Scores for English and Math
 - ACT Requirement: Math Section-20 or higher
 English Section- 18 or higher
 - Accuplacer Requirement- 5 on English section, 267 for Math section. ACT Math subtest and make an A, B, or C in your high school Algebra II.
 - High School Course Prerequisite

*Accuplacer is free for students' first attempt, \$25 for additional attempts after a waiting period. Student A-Number is required for placement testing. Remote testing is available.



CONTINUOUS ELIGIBILITY

Students will maintain continuous eligibility so long as they earn a grade of C or better in <u>all</u> (academic & technical) attempted college courses.

Students who do not meet minimum grade requirements OR withdraw from a course will be ineligible for a minimum of one term.

- May not be served during the summer.
- Students who wish to withdraw must do so through the Coastal Alabama Dual Enrollment website.

Withdrawing from courses or not meet minimum grades may affect future college financial aid eligibility!

PARTICIPATION



Courses have participation requirements and may be cancelled if there are not enough students registered



Required textbooks, equipment, and lab fees must be purchased by the student.



Students can view account information and pay online balances through their OneACCS account



COASTAL BOOKS+

- Money-saving program for course materials
- \$24 per registered credit hour automatically added
- Does not cover lab kits for Science courses
- General studies and computer science only, all other programs are opted out.

New Students

Enroll as a student at Coastal Alabama Community College

- Complete online application on the Coastal Alabama Dual Enrollment Website
- Submit enrollment documentation to high school counselor
- Dual Enrollment Approval Form
- Transcript

Dual enrollment staff will process applications, admit, and register students for their courses!

NEXT STEPS FOR BOTH ACADEMIC AND TECHNICAL STUDENTS

Students have holds on their accounts and may not make changes to their schedules

The student email address and password is the key to being a successful student at Coastal Alabama!

- After dual staff process student applications, student email information is sent in a final acceptance letter
- Instructors will communicate with students only through Coastal Alabama email

IMPORTANT

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College attendance policy is not the same as the school policy - follow the instructor's syllabus!

Courses will follow the College calendar and may not line up with high school calendar (spring break, final exams, etc.)

Required items:

- Coastal Alabama Student ID (Free)
- Parking pass for on-campus courses (\$20)

SUMMER ORIENTATION

Orientation sessions will be offered at the end of summer to help students login to their accounts and prepare for the upcoming semester.

Attendance is strongly encouraged.
