IMPORTANT: Deadline to register your child is July 19<sup>th</sup>. Don't forget – 2 proofs of residency are required per county policy. Super easy to upload a digital copy while you are registering your child in PowerSchool.

# How do I find out who my child's teacher will be this year?

FIRST, your child must be registered by July 19<sup>th</sup> to have a teacher assigned to him/her. This year we are having a special digital "reveal" that will be sent to parents through Remind on July 30<sup>th</sup>. We will have a countdown and a specific time frame in which all "reveals" will be sent at the same time. We are so excited to make this special and exciting for our students! In this digital reveal, school information will be sent as well regarding carline, bus, etc. We hope having all the information right there at your fingers will be helpful as you prepare for this upcoming school year.

# How can I find out what bus my child rides or information about carline?

Information will be sent in the teacher reveal on July 30<sup>th</sup> but more specific information will also be available regarding buses at Meet the Teacher on August 5<sup>th</sup>. Parents will have the opportunity to find out your child's bus, meet the bus driver, and get a car line tag if needed. If your child will be a car rider at any point this year, a guardian MUST have an FWE Car Rider tag displayed in the windshield, which they will receive at Meet the Teacher. Important Note: There will be no HOV car line due to the safety of our students who require special transportation.

- 7:35 Breakfast ends
- 7:45 Car Line ends and doors are closed; Students should be in class
  \*After 7:45 am, parents must sign the student in through the office.
- 7:50 Students are tardy and must report to office
- 2:50 Dismissal for Bus Riders
- 2:55 Dismissal for Car Riders, Walkers, or After School Care
