

Car Line Flow

When cars pull into the carline, fill up all the spaces on the paved lane until there is only room for one car to pass behind you. The next car to pull in begins a new car line through the grass to Cone A, farthest to the right. This car line fills up until there is only room for one car to pass behind; the next car starts a new line at the second cone from the right, Cone B. This process continues with Cones C and D in order to keep cars off Hwy 31. When the carline begins to move, all the cars in the paved lane move first. The cars behind Cone A follow the last car on the paved lane; Cone B and after follow in order. It is important to remember NOT to cut into the paved lane if there are other lanes on the grass. Always enter the line of cars farthest left. These are the last ones to enter.
