- **Hygiene Items**
(shampoo, conditioner, brushes, toothpaste, toothbrushes, deodorant, bubble bath)
- **Clothing/Shoes**
(play clothes, dresses, pants, pajamas, socks, panties)
Shelby-size 12/13 clothes, size 4 shoes (youth)
Ashton-size 4T clothes, size 9 shoes (toddler)
- **School Supplies**
(crayons, glue, scissors, pencils, handwriting paper, construction paper)

(age appropriate for 1st grade and 4 years old; topics such as princesses, Disney characters, Easy Readers, etc.)
