- ❖ Community College of the Air Force
  - Accredited by Southern Association of Colleges and Schools
  - Enrollment is automatic with no tuition
  - Awards an AS degree in over 66 technical fields (based on individual's Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) upon enlistment
  - Associate to Baccalaureate Cooperative (AU-ABC) directs Airman with AS to a collection of accredited colleges and universities to consider when completing a four-year degree. The program maximizes the application of military career education and training, and provides a multitude of online academic and support services for the enlisted member.
  
- ❖ Montgomery GI Bill-Selective Reserve (MGIB-SR)
  - No Cost to Member
  - Applies to all degree programs
  - Receive up to \$397.00 a month
  
- ❖ MGIB Kicker
  - Select AFSC's (Aircraft Maintenance, Medical Technicians, Logistics)
  - Offers an extra \$350.00 in conjunction with MGIB-SR
  
- ❖ Tuition Assistance
  - \$4,500.00 a year
  - 100% Tuition assistance (cap \$250.00 per semester hour)
  - Requires education plan/college goals
  - Applies towards undergraduate and graduate degree programs
