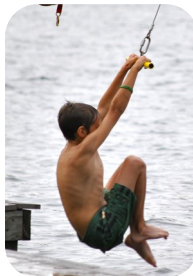


FUNDING

CONFIDENCE

A week away from home can be scary for both child and parent when asthma is involved. After six days at camp, these fears are eased thanks to the caring instructions each child receives from the medical staff. The all volunteer staff includes doctors, nurses, and respiratory therapists. They spend one-on-one time with each child. Campers attend daily classes about asthma and how to live with asthma. They come away knowing that they control their asthma; their asthma doesn't control them.



NEW EXPERIENCES

For one unforgettable week, children get to indulge in all of the camp activities such as horseback riding, swimming, canoeing, archery, sports, games, arts and crafts.



LOCATION

Camp WheezeAway is held at YMCA Camp Chandler in Wetumpka, Alabama. Camp Chandler is located on beautiful Lake Jordan. Campers are supervised around the clock by trained camp counselors. A 24-hour medical staff gives each child their medicines as ordered by their physician, and a doctor is always present. Children eat 3 meals a day and all food allergies are accommodated. Parents can breathe easier as every effort is made to provide a safe and fun experience.
