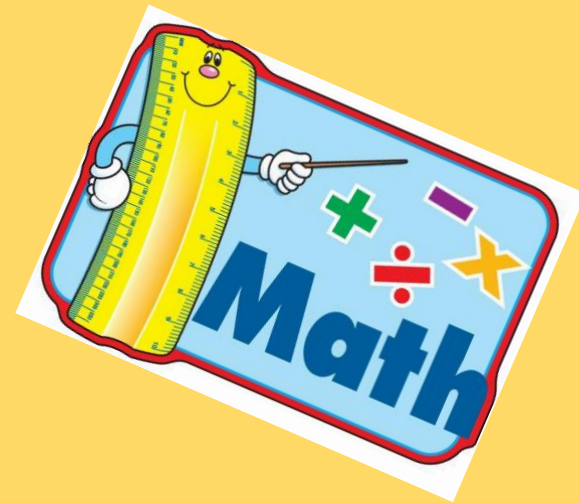

IXL is a website that allows engaging and adaptive learning for math and language arts.

Students take STAR Math and STAR Reading assessments in August and again in December. Results from each assessment set paths in the Freckle program for students to work on skills.

- Continuously adapts for student practice in Math and ELA activities.
- Increases student growth and proficiency through standards-based skill development in Math and ELA.
- Incentives and age-appropriate designs provide a balance of fun and learning. Rewards for achievement recognize student growth in ways they think are fun.

Accelerated Reader (A.R.)

Students take STAR Reading assessments in August and again in December. Results from each assessment determine the student's reading range.

There are two themed AR competitions: August - December and January - April.

Students are to earn AR points from library books they read and then test on, maintaining 80% or higher comprehension.

During each competition, the goal is to reach the different point clubs:

10-Point Club * 25-Point Club * 50-Point Club * 75-Point Club

Yearly 35-Point Club - Students earn an AR t-shirt

Yearly 100-Point Club - Students earn a field trip

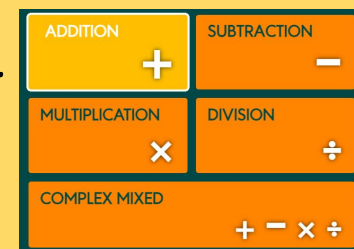


Math Magician

Math Magician is a website that allows our students to practice their basic math facts in all 4 operations.

- *Addition (+2 through +10 and mixed practice)*
- *Subtraction (-1 through -10 and mixed practice)*
- *Multiplication (x1 through x10 and mixed practice)*
- *Division (÷1 through ÷10 and mixed practice)*

Students have 1 minute to answer 20 problems in each individual skill and then 5 minutes to answer 100 problems in the mixed practice.



Sora-Audible Books

- Sora is an award-winning digital reading app that empowers K-12 students to discover age-appropriate ebooks, audiobooks and more from their school library.
- Sora is provided and purchased for you by Baldwin County. This app can be found in your student's bcbe portal on their chromebook.
- With Sora, you can get free ebooks and audiobooks from your school. Digital books are automatically returned on their due dates, so you never need to worry about late fees. When you sign into Sora for the first time, make sure to use your students email address through their bcbe portal.

- *Books from top publishers picked by experts*
- *Read aloud option allows students to listen to the story as they read*
- *Parent dashboard allows parents to be involved in their child's reading and activities, follow their progress, and even see what they're reading during the school day*
- *Books can be downloaded offline to read anywhere and anytime*
- *Built in dictionary to help students with unfamiliar words*
- *Students can find and collect vocab words as they read*
- *Books come with built in comprehension quizzes to test understanding and boost comprehension skills*
