What Every Foley Middle School Student Needs to Know

- The car rider drop-off and pick-up line is located at the back of the school between the building and the gym. Enter the car line from Pine Street. Students may not be dropped off at the front of the school. Drop off begins at 7:15. Students may NOT be dropped off prior to 7:15.
- Upon arrival at school, go to the cafeteria if you are eating breakfast. If you aren't eating breakfast, go to the gym and sit in the bleachers. You may also go to the library.
- If you are late but arrive before 8:00 am, go to 1st period. If you arrive later than 8:00am, check in at the upstairs office.
- No cell phones, earbuds, or headphones may be out or in use from 7:50-3:05.
- The dress code is strictly enforced. A copy of this policy can be found at <u>www.bcbe.org</u>. This includes no hoods/hats may be worn in the building.
- At the end of the day, walkers and car riders will be dismissed first at **3:00**. 1st wave bus students will be dismissed at **3:05pm**. All students will exit the building through the bus chute doors. An announcement will be made for all second wave bus students and athletes to go to the bus area to wait for their buses to be called. Your 7th period teacher will let you know whether you are a first or second wave bus.
- If you are not sure what bus you should ride, let the office know during 1st period. Do
 not wait until the end of the day to ask. You may not ride a different bus without
 administrator approval. This must be approved with a note from parent during the
 beginning of the day.
- Come to school every day. If you must be absent, turn your excuse in to your 1st period teacher within <u>3</u> days of returning to school. It is your responsibility to find out what work you missed while absent and complete it in a timely manner. Only 9 parent note excuses are allowed per year. The rest must be doctor excuses. You may not miss more than 18 total days per school year. This includes excused absences or unexcused absences.
- Be sure to write down your PowerSchool login information and store them in a safe place just in case you forget them. You need to log in to PowerSchool weekly to check your grades. Logins and passcodes may not be shared with other students.

- The elevator is not for student use without a note from a doctor or a principal.
- You may check out 4 library books at a time. Overdue books will result in a ten cent fine per day.
- Students may not receive deliveries at school. This includes fast food, flowers, balloons, etc. during school hours. No items may be dropped off after 9:00 a.m.
- Students may not cut through the cafeteria during lunch time transitioning to class. Students should walk on the right side of the hallway during transitions.
- Refillable containers are allowed on campus for water.
- You may bring a lock for a locker that will be assigned to you once you bring the lock. Lock combinations must be provided to the front office.
- All students are required to have closed toed shoes for PE each day.
- Our expectations are that ALL students will treat each other, all staff members, and school property with <u>Respect and Pride</u>. We expect <u>ALL</u> students to be positive leaders and model appropriate behaviors.
