What time does school start and end?

Arrival/Dismissal Schedule

- 7:00 Car Riders unload and report to Cafeteria for breakfast or Cafeteria Lobby
- 7:15 Buses unload and report to the Cafeteria for breakfast or Classroom
- 7:35 Breakfast ends
- 7:45 Instruction begins; Students should be in class
- 7:50 Students are tardy and must report to office
- 3:00 Dismissal for 1st Wave Bus and Car Riders
- 3:15 Dismissal for 2nd Wave Bus and After-School Care

Please note:

Morning Car Riders: Car Riders may start unloading at 7:00am. We hope this will HELP with morning traffic and social distancing for breakfast.

****TIP: DO NOT wait until 7:30 to – 7:45 and expect for traffic to flow smoothly.** If you arrive in car line between 7:30 – 7:45, you will be waiting. Then, your child could possibly be tardy. We are in this together! However, parents, we need your help in getting to school earlier than normal. **We are anticipating A LOT of Car Riders!**

Afternoon Car Riders: WARNING – this will take time! There is no getting around it. As previously stated, we are anticipating A LOT of Car Riders! I can assure you; we are working HARD and our absolute BEST to get kids to their cars as quickly as possible.

NOTE: YOU MUST HAVE A CAR LINE TAG issued by our office to pick up your child. This is a safety precaution.

Transportation Questions?

Bus Drivers will be on campus **Monday, August 10th from 5:00 – 6:00 pm** outside our cafeteria to help you find what bus your child will ride. **NOTE: BUS ROUTES HAVE CHANGED!** Come find out more information!

Car Line tags will be passed out during this time on Monday as well.

Can I walk my student to class the 1st day?

Unfortunately, visitors are **not** allowed on campus at this time per BCBE policy.

What time will my student be late?

Car Rider line ends at 7:45 and doors will be closed. Per our schedule, the **Tardy Bell is at 7:50am.** **If an EES Staff member is not outside in Car Line, DO NOT drop your child off without Adult supervision.** Please drive around to the front of the school to check your child in. (See Parent/Student Handbook for Check-In Policy.)

Can there be designs on my child's mask?

Students in Grades 2-6 must wear a mask at this time. Masks do not have to be a certain color or design. However, the mask can't be offensive in any way or contain inappropriate sayings or designs.

When will we receive our T-shirts we bought for this school year?

There are 2 options:

- 1) If you have already paid for your t-shirts, you can come by Monday, August 10th from 5:00 – 6:00pm outside the cafeteria to pick up your t-shirts.
- 2) If you didn't get a chance to come by on Monday, August 10th, T-shirts will be sent home with your child on Wednesday, August 12th.
