As we know, reading outside of the classroom is critical for maintaining and expanding a child's literacy skills, especially over the summer break. Research indicates that students should spend a minimum of twenty minutes a day reading outside of the classroom - both during the summer and school year.

In an effort to keep all of our students reading on (and above) grade-level over the summer months, all K-6 schools will receive take home summer reading packs. The resources will support reading across content areas and math development. The take-home packs will include materials to enhance comprehension, fluency, vocabulary and support with math skills.


