AlaKiDS

ALABAMA KINDERGARTEN INVENTORY OF DEVELOPING SKILLS

Kindergarten students are assessed with AlaKiDS in August. AlaKiDS is a whole child assessment given the first month of kindergarten that will provide the kindergarten teacher with needed information on a child's independent skills and abilities. This will be a valuable tool to help guide instruction and set goals for each child.



STAR™ Assessments

STAR is used to assess students in grades kindergarten through six in August, December, and May. STAR assessments are computer-adaptive tests designed to give educators accurate, reliable, and valid data quickly so that they can make good decisions about instruction and intervention. Parents will receive a performance report within a few weeks after the assessment.



Curriculum based measure tests called CBM's are administered to all children three times per year with the STAR tests. Intervention students are tested on a monthly basis. A CBM test allows teachers to accurately assess students' development so they can better target instruction and intervention to each learner's specific needs.



Alabama Comprehensive Assessment Program

Finally, the Alabama Comprehensive Assessment Program, ACAP, is Alabama's high-stakes test for students in grades 2-8 administered in April. All students in grades two through eight are assessed in math and language arts. Only students in grades four and six are assessed in science. **Students who fail to score a proficient score in third grade may be retained as per the Alabama Literacy Act**.

SCHOOL BUS

If you are biking home, notify your child's teacher several days before so they can secure a walker pass for you. Then change your dismissal to "Walker" and pick up kids at the double doors just west of the Cafeteria with your walker pass. If you forget to get a walker pass, you can pick one up in the office.

SCHOOL RULES:

- Bikes should always be walked on sidewalks once on campus.
- Students must wear a helmet (it's the law!) and be accompanied by an adult.
- Students on bikes should enter the campus by the HOV line entrance on Fairwood, walk their bikes down the big hill, and park on the north side of campus near the cafeteria doors. Please do not enter campus from Section St. at the HOV line exit.

Welcome School Dismissal Mana

School Dismissal Manager is an online system that informs all parties of transportation changes with a few clicks of a button. This reduces the chance of error. Beginning September 13, 2021, FWE will begin using School Dismissal Manager for afternoon dismissal changes. The system promises to be easy. Detailed instructions will be coming to you on September 8, 2021. In addition, the Student Handbook, located on the school website, has a section with more specific information about SDM.
