

2019 FIS Science Fair FAQs.

1. 2019 Dates:

- 4th Grade: May 1st (Wednesday)
- 5th Grade: April 26th (Friday)
- 6th Grade: May 7th (Tuesday)

2. Is the Science Fair required?

- Yes.

3. Set-up Take-down Times:

- Set up at beginning of school (7:30 – 8:00 am.)
- Check in with teacher to learn class sets up together or students individually set up upon arrival
- Displays may be taken down after 1:45 p.m. All must be removed at the end of the day.

4. Does everyone have to have a trifold display board?

- Yes. They are available at Walmart, Dollar Tree, Staples and many other places.

5. Judging:

- Judging is 8 am to 11:30 am.
- When class is judged will be scheduled soon (depends upon teachers schedules / PE, etc)
- Parents may not stand next to child or coach during judging

6. Missing Deadline?

Entry Form:

- If a student misses the deadline on entry form, they must turn in entry form ASAP.
- Late entry point deduction will be applied for 6th grade.

Project:

- Forgotten projects must still be presented when brought to school.
- Student absence on Science Fair: Student will present project when returned to school.
