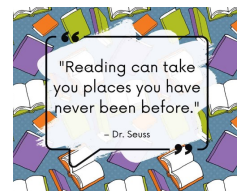
Library Hours: 8:00 am – 3:00 pm

The goal of our school library is to provide quality print and digital resources for our students while fostering the development of information literacy skills. Our purpose is to build successful 21st Century students who can think critically and creatively as well as communicate and collaborate with one another. We strive to promote a lifelong love of reading.

Each class has a regularly scheduled, weekly library class. This month, library lessons for all grades will focus on library rules and procedures. Students will learn how to locate just right books, self-checkout, and take care of library books/resources. We will also introduce the Accelerated Reader Program in grades 1st-6th.

Check-out policies



- **1st – 2nd Grade** students may check out **1 book** at a time.
- **3rd – 6th Grade** students may check out **2 books** at a time.

- Please encourage your child to treat library books with care. Use a bookmark and avoid liquids! Books that are lost or damaged will need to be replaced. Missing book notices that include a replacement fee will be sent home as needed.
